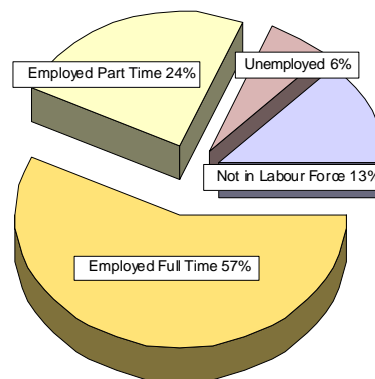

 - ! 134 or 28% were employed part-time.

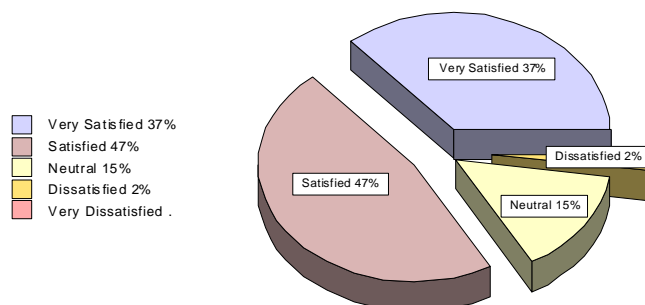
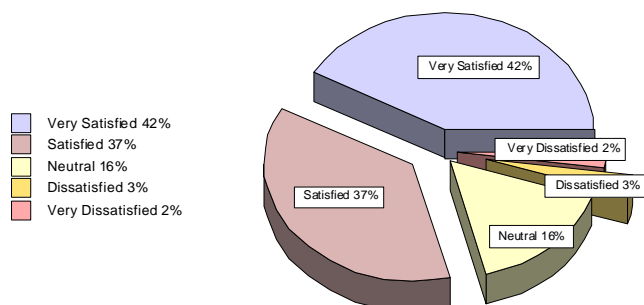


PROGRAM CLUSTER SATISFACTION:
