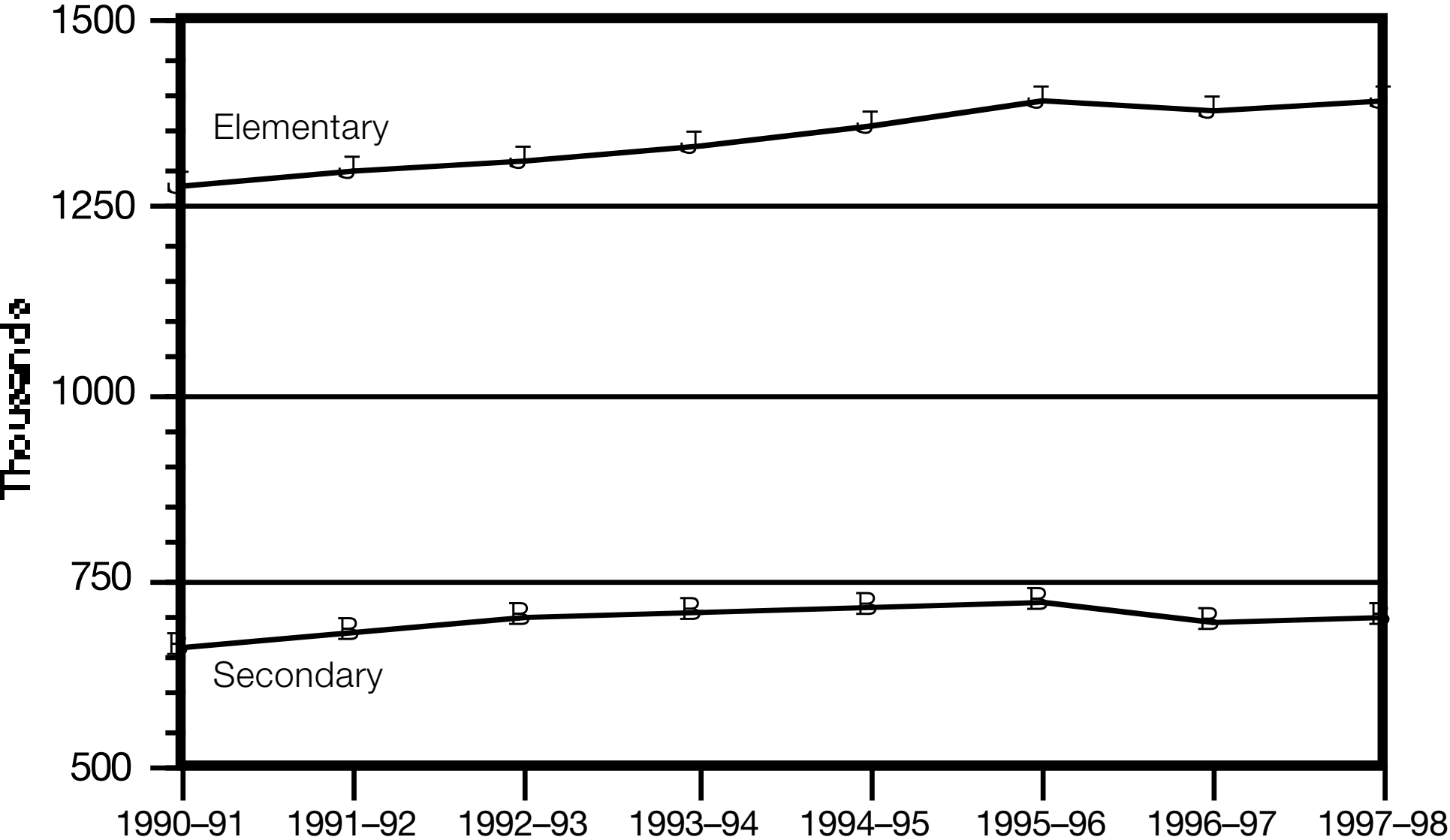

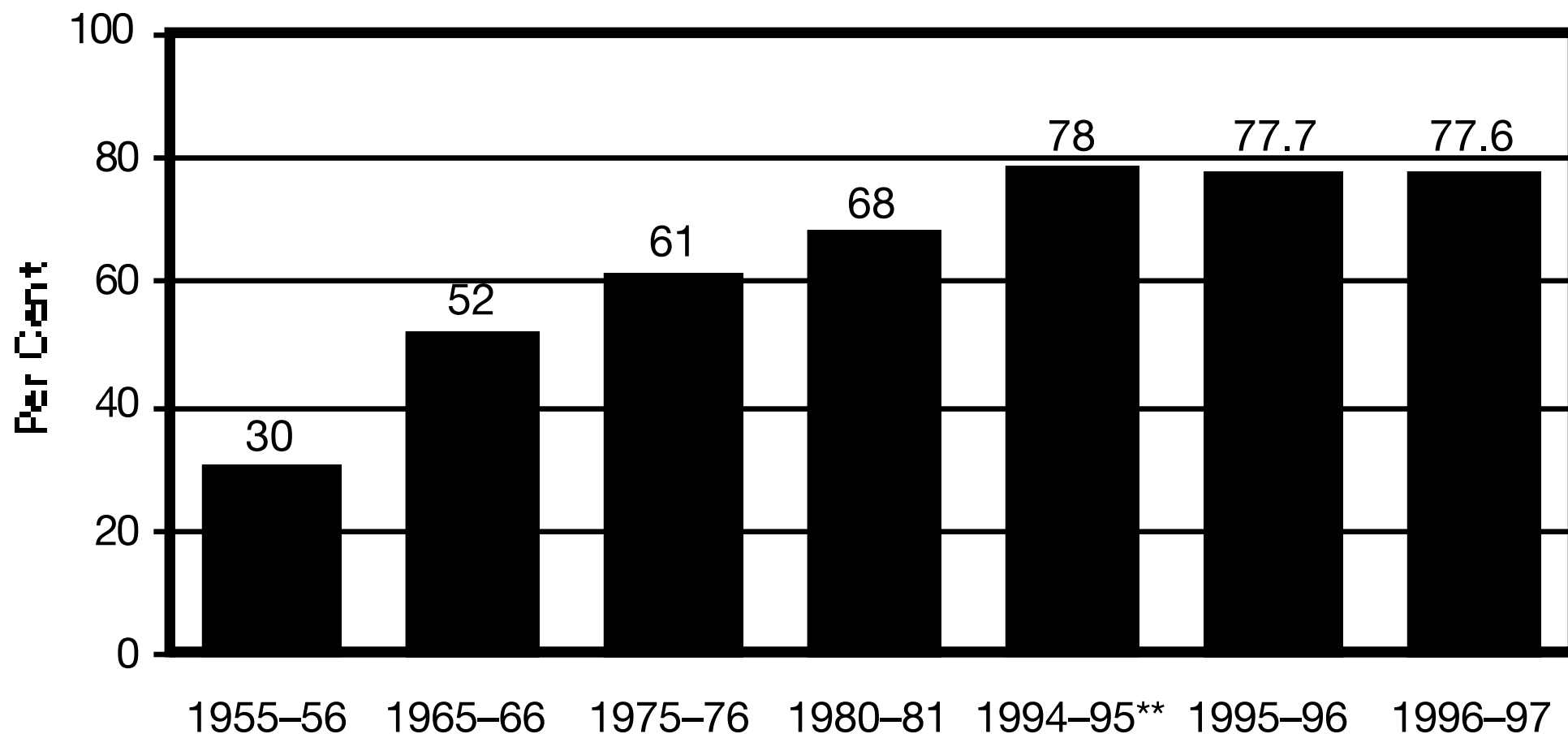

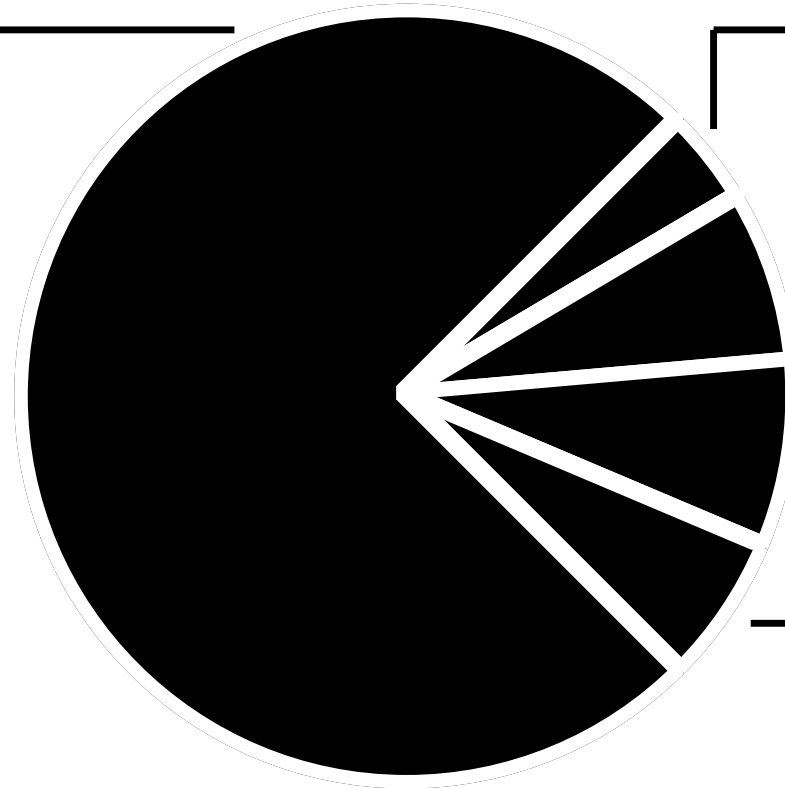

Cost-sharing Arrangement, 1997*

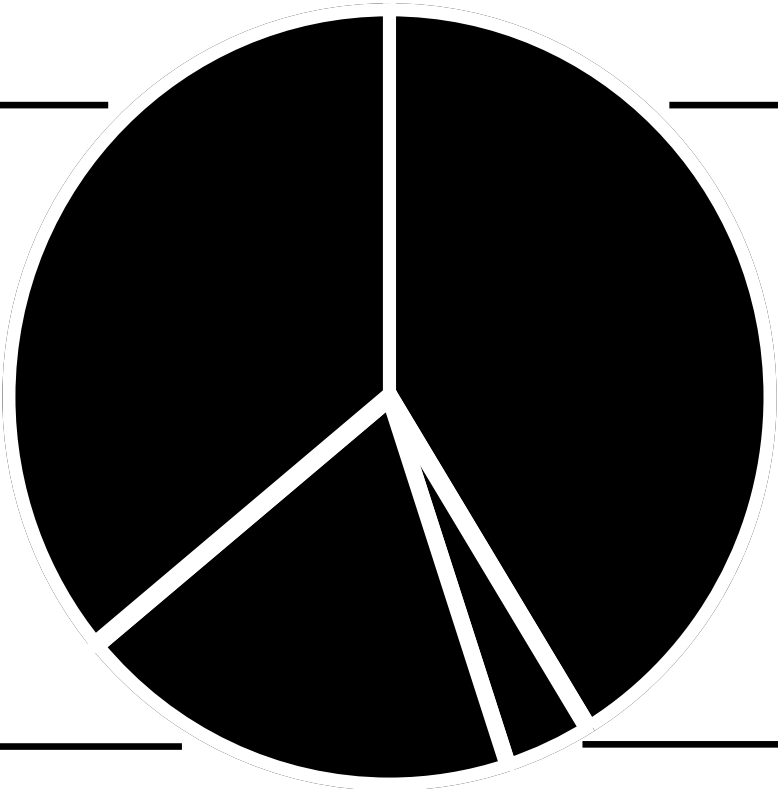
